Course description - Including aims & objectives

The Wing Chun system of Kung Fu is quite simple in comparison to other Kung Fu styles. There is a distinct lack of acrobatic leaps and extreme looping motions. It is a system based on the motions of the human body not on animals. The entire system is very accessible to all abilities, ages and genders.

The aim of this course is to give learners and opportunity to gain a basic understanding of the Wing Chun system, to improve confidence, learn self-defence and improve fitness levels.

Objectives will be measured though observation in sessions and via response to written questions.

How Progress & Success will be recorded:

Progress will be recorded through observation during sessions and if appropriate the answering of written assessments.

Any further next steps

This is a beginners session - further classes will have to be discussed and would depend on the abilities in the class.
