Course description - Including aims & objectives

A fun, hands-on workshop for anyone who would like to try working with glass. You will work with a number of pre-cut shapes of glass and will also need to do a small amount of glass cutting. We will be making 6 decorations – there will be 3 different designs and you will make 2 of each. As glass needs 8-12 hours in the kiln, your pieces will be taken home by the tutor and fired. They can then be collected from the school within a week.

How Progress & Success will be recorded:

Throughout the evening, you will be supported by the tutor, who will encourage you to develop your cutting and design skills allowing you to become more confident which will show within your pieces.

What else will you need to do	We ask all students to complete an enrolment form which asks for details required by the Education & Skills Funding Agency & the county council and is a requirement of entry to the course. We ask for full payment prior to the course beginning. Please note refunds can only be made if a class is cancelled or closed.
