WHY SHOULD I CHOOSE THIS STUDY PROGRAMME?

The Level 3 Media course offers a wide range of units to reflect the range of opportunities available within the media sector. It is an ideal foundation for students interested in a career in the media sector, providing them with understanding of media through engagement with media products, production processes and technologies. This leads to the application of practical and creative skills that transfer easily into the workplace.

WHAT WILL I STUDY?

As part of this course you will:

- Plan and produce a talk and music radio programme
- Study the UK film industry
- Study the UK music industry
