WHY SHOULD I CHOOSE THIS SUBJECT

The course will be delivered over the duration of two years and will be the equivalent of one, possibly two A levels (A Triple Award Qualification) The course will allow for the exploration and learning of a wide and varied range of performing arts disciplines, from Acting, Stage Management and/or Musical Theatre. The possibilities are endless!

The learning and development of skills will come from Teaching Specialists at the College, alongside professional engagement from the wealth and rich Drama and Theatre industry that is accessible within Ely, Cambridge, Norwich, London and beyond. The focus of the course being to prepare students for University or work within the Performing Arts.

WHAT WILL I STUDY?

Students will need to complete five mandatory units and up to a further 5 optional units. Units range from 'Preparing to Working within the Performing Arts' to 'Performing Character' or 'Directing Theatre' to name just a few!

The course is flexible and diverse depending on a variety of skills and interests. Pathways available are Acting, Dance Music, Musical Theatre or Theatre Production

WHAT COULD THIS QUALIFICATION LEAD TO?

The focus of the course being to prepare students for University level study of Drama, Theatre and Performing Arts or Drama School or work within the Performing Arts.
